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MISCELLANEOUS EVENTS AND REMARKS SECTION

1. A short note on above; play begins at 8:30 Sat morning, bring own boards and men, Staunton type, if possible.
2. Listed below are a few things everyone will have to give some thought to, as they will be discussed at the players meeting at the Open:
 - a. We need one more tournament later this year, about Nov or Dec, where, when and who will take on the basic organization of this?
 - b. Sioux Falls players should have some information on the 1966 S. F. Open, it is a little early to set up dates but the month and place could be discussed briefly.
 - c. Election of officers and the creation of a new office or two. A representative of the Chess Asso. should be present in a couple more locations in the state.
 - d. Location and approx. time of 1966 S Dak Open.
 - e. State dues, the association needs a little more money to operate and one answer is the raising of state dues to \$3.00 for state residents and possibly leaving it at \$2.00 for out of state players. This, of course, would not take effect until after the Open. Just take a look at the financial statement if you don't think we need a few dollars. A bigger and better trophy and other prizes would be the result at the State Open if a few dollars more could be spent, possibly two trophies. One more dollar won't break any of us I'm sure and it would be a great help to our organization.
