Entry \$5, USCF and SDCA (\$2) membership required. Registration closes at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 19. Prizes: State Title to the top South Dakota player. 1st, 40% of entry; 2nd, 20%; 3rd, 15%. Trophies to top South Dakota player, classes A, B, C+D+E, and Unrated. The top SD player will be ineligible for the class trophy, which will go to the next highest scorer in that class.
