PENQUITE WINS SIOUX FALLS OPEN

John Penquite, Des Moines, IA, won 1st in the A Division with $4\frac{1}{2}$, finishing ahead of thirty-one players. The first Sioux Falls Open held since 1967 drew the strongest field of any S D tourney in the last twenty years. The meet was held at the YMCA on 6-7 May 72. A three way tie for 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the A division at 4-1 kept the final results in doubt till the very end. 1st prize was a nice trophy and \$100.00. Cash prizes were also awarded to winners in B, C and unrated divisions. Bryant Holmes, sioux Falls, won the B prize along with Dave Handy at $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$. Gary Campbell won Class C, leading 3 others on tie-breaks. Jim McIntyre topped the unrated players, beating out Bob Reynolds on tie-breaker points. Players in the tourney represented five states, including several individuals who either are, or were at one time, state champions of various states. The tourney was well organized and directors Art Tollerison, Sam Priebe & Gerald Mortimer of Sioux Falls are to be commended for their efforts to promote Chess in the Sioux Falls area.

1972 So Dak Chess Association Business Meeting - Official announcement, in accordance with current SDCA By-laws, is given this date of the 1972 Annual Business Meetings & Officer Elections to be held at the State Closed in Pierre on 24-25 Jun 72. Items for discussion are listed below. Players meetings held at S F Open in May 72 brought several problems in various areas which must be resolved. The intent of the below list is to give all interested parties adequate time to study the issues and bring up whatever they wish during the meetings. Due to limited time for the meetings in June it is urged that all parties formulate their ideas on the areas and have them prepared for presentation to facilitate an efficient meeting. It is planned to have a meeting on 24 Jun for purposes of revising current operating rules of the association and the meeting on Sunday for election of President, Vice-President, the Executive Council and appointment of the Sec & Treasurer. Ref is made to Articles of S D by-laws in some cases:

Article III - Official headquarters of organization shall be the secretarys office or as designated by Executive committee at each Annual meeting

Article IV - the governing power of the SDCA shall be vested in the Executive Committee

Article V - Should the organization have membership dues or a % from each rated tourney held under the SDCA Chapter to finance activities?

Article VI - General discussion on who, when & where official meetings should be authorized and the minimum attendance of selected personnel to be present to conduct official SDCA business.

Article X - Powers & duties of exec committe & representative of sections of state.

Article XI - Conduct of USCF rated tournaments under SD Chapter authorization. Proper notification of SDCA officials; proper notification of SD players & other states if open tournament; proper notification of USCF of results & also notification of SD Chess Bulletin of results; establishment of uniform system of determining State Champion & Jr Champion, either by closed meet or playoff of some type; method of selection of SD USCF director to represent state.

Publication of bulletin - Where & how often - Content of material required

S D Closed meets for SD Champion - What constitutes resident status for SDCA purposes & method of approval of questionable entries

Appointment of committee to rewrite the By-laws in a manner that will be applicable to the SDCA & meeting of this committe to determine when project is to be finished for presentation to a special meeting to finalize the document. Possible meeting at some tourney between state meets or either next years state business meeting.
