1. The SDCA is updating the mailing list in an effort to provide all interested chessplayers with the latest in local chess news and plans for future events. As postage costs are high the mailing of bulletins to individuals or organizations that are not interested is considered infeasible.
2. The bottom portion of this sheet is for completion with your latest current address and return to the SDCA. Following are instructions on use of this form:
 - (1) If you are an out of state addressee and wish to continue to receive all publications put out by SDCA you must return this sheet with \$1.00.
 - (2) If you are an out of state addressee and wish to receive only the bulletin that reports the tournament that you participate in you need not return this as tournament report bulletins will be sent to all players that play in the tournament if the director sends proper documentation to SDCA.
 - (3) If you are an addressee in S D and have been active in a S D USCF rated tournament since May of 1971 you need not return this to remain on list.
 - (4) If you are an addressee in S D and have not been active in any USCF rated tournament in S D since May, 1971 you must return this sheet with \$1.00 to remain on mailing list.
3. The mailing list will be updated in this manner each year on or about 1 October. Above comments do not apply to trade agreements with other chess organizations or to schools which receive courtesy copies.

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THE SOUTH DAKOTA CHES ASSOCIATION AND THE PIERRE CHES CLUB EXTEND A SINCERE "THANK YOU, PIERRE CITY COMMISSION" for allowing the Pierre Chess Club to use the community room for meetings. It is appreciated by all.

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Address & player listing is being updated as you note by attached sheet. The address listing has been reviewed and completely consolidated by city. Any tournament director requiring address listing prior to next bulletin may request copy from secretary of SDCA. Approximately 150 copies of this bulletin are being sent out in an effort to publicize S D Chess & update the mailing listing.

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Tentative dates for the 1973 SD CLOSED are 30Jun-1Jul73 at Pierre S D. It looks like this should be the biggest one yet for attendance & prizes.

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Organization of the Pierre Chess Club was initiated last month. Three meetings held, attendance of 10-14 individuals so far. Could improve with cooler weather.

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SDCA received letter from group of players in Faulkton S D on forming a chess club and requesting information on S D chess tournaments. Effort to have a match set up with Pierre is in the thought stage at this printing.

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Anyone who has a friend who is interested in chess drop name & address to the SDCA. A sample copy of next bulletin will be mailed to him/her. Of course if individual is in same town they can read yours, save SDCA postage.

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A rating tourney is being planned for Pierre in January or February 73. If sufficient interest is noted in this area in the next couple months a city tournament may also be set up.

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Tournament directors are reminded that any tournaments held in S D under the Chapter of the SDCA, which are USCF rated and so reported to USCF, must be approved prior to the tourney being advertised or held. Tournament directors are also reminded that 5% of gross entry fees and 50% of the 20% savings on new USCF or renewals are to be contributed to the SDCA. 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Request delinquent reports and SDCA fees for 2 tournaments which are outstanding at this time be forwarded by tournament director.

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Send in items of news for the next bulletin to reach SDCA no later than 1 Dec 72. Items will be printed if space & time permit, none can be returned except by request of sender.
