CHESS PLAYERS & TOURNAMENTS

1972 LEAD GOLDEN OPEN held 21-23 Dec 72, won by Harold Bayley. Full report in bulletin.

USCF board rules out any further individual matches for rating purposes except when for playoff reasons from a tournament tie. This effective 1Jan73.

Quarterly update of USCF ratings will no longer be published, only the Annual list in Chess Life & Review. USCF will put out a monthly supplement to update ratings, the first dated Jan 73. The Jan 73 list included two SD tournaments, 1972 Great Plains Open, Nov, Sioux Falls & Sioux Empire Rating Tourney, Sep, 1972, Sioux Falls S D. To aid tournament directors and individuals in keeping up with current ratings for pairing purposes the SDCA will publish ratings from the current listings from USCF of players who participate in current tournaments in S D. This list will be S D players only, specific information on out of state players may be secured by request to the SDCA sec, Box 634, Pierre S D 57501 with a stamped & addressed envelope for return to requesting director. Twelve players were entered in the rated section with a three way tie causing a \$70.00 prize fund to divide three ways. Harold Bayley of Lead placed 1st on tie-breaks, Terry Likens of Rapid City 2nd and Rick Likens of Hardin Montana 3rd.

An interesting battle developed between the top 4 finishers. Harold Bayley won from Rick Likens and lost to Terry Likens. Dr Kryger won from Terry but lost to Rick. Dr Kryger had the highest tie-breaks in the meet.

In the Novice tourney there were 9 entries. Bill Herman from Rapid City won the 1st Place trophy with a perfect score of 4 wins. Kenneth Gienger and Steve Morris, both of Lead, tied for 2nd with Gienger winning 2nd place trophy on tie-breaks.

Director of the meet and organizer was Arthur W Bayley, 124 May St, Lead S D. A check for \$8.65 was received from the director for SDCA operating expenses.

Four new memberships were secured to USCF. South Dakota is slowly growing in membership to the national organization. It is tournaments that cause this growth. The SDCA can only express its appreciation to all tournament directors with the word "THANKS". South Dakota needs tournaments if we are going to keep growing in the Chess World.
