

SOUTH DAKOTA CHESS ASSOCIATION BULLETIN

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TOLLEFSON WINS 1973 CLOSED

Art Tollefson, Sioux Falls, won the 1973 South Dakota Closed Championship held in Pierre on 30 Jun - 1 Jul 73. Tollefson and Bryant Holmes, Sioux Falls, tied for 1-2 with $4\frac{1}{2}$ points each, playing a drawn game in their 4th round encounter. First place and the Trophy for S D Champion for 1973 went to Art on tie-breaks. Robert Wallace and Jerry Mortimer tied for 3-4 with Wallace slightly ahead on tie-breaks. The 1973 S D Jr Champion is Kevin Gaustad of Sioux Falls based on his 6th place finish, highest of 11 Jr entries. (excluding Tollefson who was named Sr Champion) Jerry Mortimer was re-elected president, James Williamson of Lake Andes elected East River player representative and Terry Likens of Rapid the west river appointee. Pierre was selected to host the 1974 S D Closed, date to be determined at a later date & announced in January or February 1974.

A players meeting was held for discussion of the Annual Business of the SDCA and the following items were considered:

1. It was decided to continue the policy of all tournament directors to submit a minimum of 5% of the gross entries \$ to the SDCA for operation of our bulletin & business. If the director has a club to help support then the other half (5%) can be kept for his local operation. If not, then 10% of gross entries \$'s should be sent to the SDCA Sec Gary Wallace, Box 634, Pierre S D 57501.
2. Recommendations for changes in the bulletin were asked for and the only major item discussed was the possibility of including game scores in the bulletin. At this time no decision was made but it was generally agreed that if time permits a game or two per bulletin might be desirable, when games were of significance and available time permitted the publishing.
3. General agreement was reached, after much discussion, on what guidelines should be followed to determine who is eligible for the S D Closed which is the annual tourney to decide the S D Sr & Jr Champions. It was decided as follows: Armed Forces personnel on active duty may play if they are on permanent assignment in S D and have been in the state for 30 days or more. TDY personnel in S D are not eligible; All other participants must have an established resident address, mailing address and voting residence and been a continuous resident for over 90 days; College students who are S D residents but are attending college out of state may participate if they maintain a legal residence status for voting in S D and do not compete for the State title in any other state; College students from out of state may play if they are officially a registered voter in S D and maintain a year around residence in the state.
4. Possible state high school meet to be organized this coming year or later this year. Terry Likens probably would organize this in Rapid City.
5. Discussion was held on the certification of directors. It was suggested that as many as possible get certified with USCF to enable tournaments to be held with proper credentials.
