Art Tollofson, S D Champion, has left to attend college this winter at Yale.

Nine Sioux Falls Area players attended the Sioux City Philanthropist Open on 14-15 Jul 73. Tollofson placed 8th in the Open division with 4-1, losing to William Martiz(2413) in the 2nd rd. Art split Class A money with 2 others.

The Sioux City Chess Club sponsored the Philanthropist Open, 14-15 Jul 73. Eighty entries in the Open Division and thirty-four in the Middle Division made this one of the largest tournaments in this immediate area and also one of the richest in prize money. Nine hundred and thirty dollars was paid out in both divisions. Winslow Elliott, St Louis Mo, (2273) won the Open Division with a 5-0 score, a clear 1st. Curt Brasket and Stephan Popel tied at 4½ for 2-3 with Bill Martz placing 4th on tie breaks over 6 others at 4-1. This tourney was a strong tourney as indicated by the above names. Nine entries were rated over 2000. Mark Wagner placed 1st over Jeff Boxell of Des Moines IA in the Middle Division, both with 4½-½. Mark is from Sioux Falls S D. Kevin Gaustad, Beresford S D, placed 7th in the Middle Div. with 3½-1½ & Rodney Kuchta, S Falls, 8th with 3-2. The event was held at the Sioux City IA YMCA and was directed by Sylvio J Scorza.

The Minnesota Chess Association has a fine monthly publication called the Northern Chess News. He has turned down millions of \$,s in offers for various commercial ventures. The Wyoming Open was held in Casper.
