1. The SDCA is updating the mailing list in an effort to provide all interested chess players in this area with the latest in S D Chess News and planning for future events. As postage costs are high the mailing of bulletins to individuals who are not interested is not practicable.

2. The bottom portion of this sheet is for completion with your latest current address and return to the SDCA if you wish to be retained on the mailing list. Please note the following comments on who must return the form to be retained, it may be that you are in a group not required to do so:

- (1) If you are an out of state addressee and wish to continue to receive all publications put out by the SDCA you must return this sheet with \$1.00.
- (2) If you are an out of state addressee and wish to receive only bulletins that report tourneys in S D in which you participate you need not return as players in each tourney receive that report automatically if proper addresses are submitted by the TD.
- (3) If you are a S D addressee and have been active in S D USCF rated events since May 1972 you will be retained on the mailing list at this time.
- (4) If you are a S D addressee and have not been active in S D Chess in the past or since May 1972 we urge you to return this sheet with \$1.00 so you will be informed of when tourneys are so you may participate when possible. Help support your state chess organization.

3. The SDCA mailing list is updated annually in this manner to facilitate the most accurate and effective mailing coverage with minimum cost. Above comments do not apply to other organizations with which we trade publication information on an exchange basis, or to schools who receive information copies from time to time. The SDCA is a non-profit organization and does not retain individuals on a salary basis.
