ANNUAL PIERRE, 1975 SD CHAMPION

The 1975 S D Closed, 21-22 Jun 75, Pierre S D, resulted in Sam Priebe, Sioux Falls, winning the 1st Place trophy and title of 1975 State Champion. Thirty-Two individuals squared off for the event which was held in the State Capitol Building. Carpet covered floors, high intensity lighting, air conditioning, cushioned chairs and fine tables made playing conditions top grade. Art Tollefson, 1973-1974 SD Champion, placed second. Five players finished with 4-1 for the top five places. New Jr Champion is Rick Likens, Rapid City. Two incidents made this tourney one which will not be forgotten easily. A large tornado funnel hanging over Pierre plus a couple of smaller ones caused a delay in the 2nd round and a power outage in the 3rd round. Although I'm sure fellow Pierrite Ed Mill didn't think it was funny at the time, his being stuck in the elevator during the power outage for 30-40 minutes brought a number of friendly jesting comments through the walls which provided a few chuckles. We have to give Ed a hand for taking this all in good nature and laughing about it later. For all who came in to Pierre the SDCA extends a "Thank You", let's make it forty next year. 1975 ANNUAL PLAYERS MEETING, SDCA

The Annual SDCA players meeting, held on 22 Jun at the SD Closed, resulted in a new Constitution being adopted for the SDCA. Copies of this document will be prepared and a copy mailed to each officer and director of the SDCA. Bylaws on dues and membership were formulated with bylaws on other areas to be acted upon by the SDCA officials during coming months. The Annual election of offices was held with the following results: President-Gerald Mortimer, Sioux Falls; E. River VP-Ed DeAntoni, Pierre; W. River VP-Terry Likens, Rapid City; Sec-Trea-Gary Wallace, Pierre; Eastern Regional Directors-Jerry Bergen, Watertown(Waubay) and David Kerihove, Sioux Falls; Western Regional Directors-Dan Schmidt, Rapid City and Arthur Bayley, Lead. Dues were set at \$5.00 for Sr and \$3.00 for Jr, 1 year. Junior membership is governed the same as USCF, your age must be 18 yr upon the expiration date of period covered by jr dues. Membership cards are being purchased and should be out within a couple months. These will be printed cards and similar to USCF cards as far as content. MEMBERSHIP IN THE SDCA IS REQUIRED FOR ALL SO DAK RESIDENTS PARTICIPATING IN USCF RATED TOURNAMENTS IN SD. MEMBERSHIP FOR OUT OF STATE PLAYERS IS OPTIONAL. If the out of state player wants to receive all copies of the SDCA bulletin then they must become a member, otherwise the player from out of state will receive only the bulletin carrying the tournament report.

Following listed individuals have paid 1 yr membership dues in the SDCA under the new constitution. New members will be listed in each bulletin for TD use. This will provide a back-up should a mbr lose his/her card and also will give recognition to supporters of SD Chess.
