JAMES WILLIAMSON SCORES 5-0

James Williamson, Lake Andes S D, placed 1st in the 1975 S D Open held in Pierre 27-28 Sep. Sixteen players were entered, all from S D. Gary Wallace, Pierre, took a clear 2nd with 4-1. Five individuals scored 3-2 with Jerry Mortimer coming out on top for 3rd on tie breaks. This was the first SD Open in recent years since the SD Closed was initiated and hopefully it will again become an annual event. MILTON WINS 1975 GREAT PLAINS OPEN

John Milton, Omaha ND, and Mike Blankenau, Lincoln ND finished with 4½-½ for 1st & 2nd. Twenty Six players participated in this annual event. Sam Priebe, Sioux Falls, placed 3rd over Terry Chitwood on tie-breaks. Milton nearly was defeated in the 1st Round by Dave Kerkhove when he was in time trouble at the 40 move level. To add to the initial time scramble Milton then took approximately 43 minutes to study the position & seal his move for an adjournment which left him with only 17 minutes to make 25 moves in the second time control. John's ability for rapid play came to his rescue as he completed his final moves with lightning rapidity. Director: G Mortimer
