Bobby Fischer has been in the news lately. AP reports from Belgrade, Yugoslavia state that Fischer has confirmed that his conditions have been met for a match with Boris Spassky. The match is being organized by Jezdimir Vasiljevic (Vasijevic?), owner of one of Yugoslavia's largest private banks. He has offered \$5 million for the rematch, \$3.35 million for the winner and \$1.65 million for the loser. One of Fischer's conditions was that all journalists be kept well away from him before the match. The match is scheduled to begin September 2. Vasiljevic has challenged Gary Kasparov to play a match against Fischer and has offered Kasparov \$500,000 for each game played with Fischer. Fischer has apparently agreed to play a second match, but match director Janos Kubat said that neither the identity of Fischer's next rival nor the amount of prize money could now be revealed.

Fischer's trip and the potential prize money are apparently in violation of U.N. sanctions imposed against Serbia-led Yugoslavia for its role in the war in Bosnia-Herzegovina. Fischer is apparently on Sveti Stefan, a resort island on the southern Adriatic coast, according to Tomislav Milojevic, chief spokesman for the match.

The six teams in the tournament finished in the order of their average rating this year. Before play began it looked to be very exciting, because of the 'ringers', Curtis Carroll for Pierre, Lyle Hanson for Aberdeen, Bruce Brandt for Sioux Falls, and the presence of a strong team from Rapid City.

In round one, there were no upsets. In round two, Aberdeen and Sioux Falls wounded each other with a draw in four decisive games. In round three, Aberdeen and Pierre drew this time there was an upset win by Arnie Mathews over Reuben Bezpaletz and two draws. In round four, Rapid City sealed Aberdeen's fate in a 3-1 victory. Round five produced a draw between Rapid City and Pierre giving Rapid City the team championship.

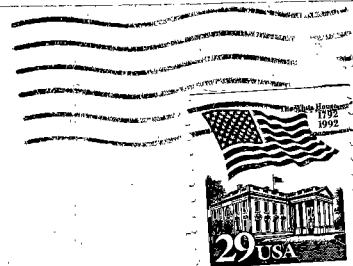
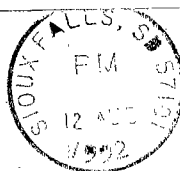
