SIoux FALLS OPEN

This year's Sioux Falls Open featured a senior master and a national master. Sioux Falls was well represented with fifteen out of the twenty-five players. Three players came from out of state including senior master Loren Schmidt from Nebraska and ex-South Dakota master, Mark Bohannon, who came from Illinois.

The tournament, as usual, included several upsets. In the first round Jeff Barth was drawn by Richard Dorset and Pat Steele drew with David Kerkhove. Pat also drew with Steve Haataja in round four. Jack Bier upset David Kerkhove in the second round and Ralph Bailey upset Harry Overholtzer in round four.

Curtis Carroll had a very good tournament with a win over Lyle Hanson and a draw with Mark Bohannon. Eric Hosen beat Steve Haataja in round three in a game which featured Eric's king marching under attack by Steve's queen and rook from g8 to e2. Eric was forced to forfeit his Sunday morning game, because he had to fix a customer's computer.

There were two players, John Gavin and David Johnson, who were playing in their first chess tournament and they both played well. John beat a 1600 player and David won two games and finished with two points.

The tournament was won by Loren Schmidt with five points. He won \$150 and five grand prix points for first place. His stiffest competition was probably given by Samer Adli. Sam Started a combination which featured queens enpris and involved sacrifices on both sides. Unfortunately for Sam, the combination ended badly for him. Sam did ask whether or not he could offer a draw on every move. Samer Adli finished second and won \$100 with a win over Louie Horton in the last round. Sam played a move which might have lost, but Louie's reply allowed Sam to win a piece and the game.

We appreciate Jeff's effort in organizing this ninth Sioux Falls Open and thank all of the persons who came and all of those who contributed to the effort.

NATIONAL ELEMENTARY CHAMPIONSHIP

Mark Knudson participated in the National Elementary Championship on April 22 through 25, 1993, in Charlotte, North Carolina. Mark is a fourth grader from Sioux Falls (11/78) and he participated in the fifth grade and under section. In the tournament, Mark won three games and lost four games and finished 118th. out of 201 players entered in that section. The first place winner had a rating of 1877. One of the persons to whom Mark lost was Matthew Hanscom of Minneapolis who finished fourth.

Mark also competed in the Bug House tournament with Michael Mosher (11/89) from Des Moines. Mark and his partner were six wins and two losses in the Bug House tournament and finished 8th. of 72 teams.

In all categories of the tournament over 2,000 players participated. Next year's tournament will be in San Jose, California.
