SCHOLASTIC EDITION National High School Championship APRIL 8-11, 1999 SIOUX FALLS CONVENTION CENTER

The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation is sponsoring the National High School Chess Tournament from April 8-11, 1999 at the Sioux Falls Convention Center. The National High School attracted over 1,000 players to Los Angeles in 1998 and over 750 players are registered at the present time. The event begins with a blitz tournament on Thursday, April 8 at 6:00pm. A bughouse tournament will be held at 9:00am on Friday, April 9. The main tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on April 9. The rounds on Friday, April 9, begin at 1pm and 6pm. Rounds 3, 4, and 5 will be held at 9, 2, and 7 on Saturday, and the final two rounds on Sunday, April 11, begin 9 and 2. Competition will be in three sections: Open, Under 1300, and Under 1000. Class prizes and team prizes will be given in each section. Plan to attend now.

We have had numerous tournaments in which scholastic players participated this year. The Winter Match, Sioux Falls-Madison VI, the Eye Open Reseve Section, the 4th Flandreau Indian Chess Club Tournament and the South Dakota Scholastic Championships. This scholastic edition of the Bulletin of the South Dakota Chess Association will feature all of these tournaments as well as a list of scholastic players and our current schedule. Although numbers have been down at the several events this year, the number of events available to scholastics has been up. The Pierre Indian Learning Center traveled to three different events this year. They brought Flanderau Indian Chess Club played in three different events and twice traveled to Sioux Falls to play the Sioux Falls Lincoln High Chess Club. The Sioux Falls Home School Association won both team trophies at Flandreau and the Junior High and Elementary Trophies at the State Scholastic. Nine Home Schoolers played at Flandreau and seventeen at the State Scholastic. All of these teams plan to be at the National High School Championship.

Madison again won our State High School Championship and brought thirteen players to that tournament. Sioux Falls Mark Twain which won the newly established primary section, brought twelve players to this tournament. We have Jud Bergan of Madison, Glen Eide and the staff of Pierre Indian Learning Center, Greg Waters and Jack Bier who works with Sioux Falls Mark Twain, Shawn DeMarrias, the coach of Flandreau Indian School, Mark Gerdes and Don Hagggar and all of the parents of the Sioux Falls Home

School Association.and Sam Ogdie of Sioux Falls O'Gorman to thank for the participation of kids in these tournaments. We would like to thank all of the persons who assist with chess clubs and all of the teachers who sponsor these clubs. Without these persons many of the persons who play in the schools would not play chess.

The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation provided all of the equipment used in the state scholastic. It also paid for memberships for Pierre Indian Learning Center, Flandreau Indian School and Riggs High School in Pierre. Last summer it paid membership fees for all the new memberships at the Ronning Library Summer Chess Club in Sioux Falls.The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation paid over \$300.00 for the trophies which were presented in the State Scholastic tournament. They also provided equipment for Riggs High School in Pierre. Six sets and boards were to donated to Sioux Falls O'Gorman for the use of their school for the State Scholastic Touranemt. WINTER MATCH

The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation sponsored its 3rd January Chess Clinic on January 16,1999. Fifty one players including 29 persons from Pierre Indian Learning Center attended the clinic. Wes Schmidt talked about how open lines and proper development of pieces helped in the attack in chess. Jeff Barth gave a presentation on how to defend your chess position. 15 time Sioux Falls City Chess Champion David Kerkhove presented a Quiz Bowl featuring a game from the 1998 US Championship. Glen Eide, chess coach from Pierre Indian Learning Center won the top prize. Jack Bier finished the clinic with a presentation of openings.

Ralph Bailey is no longer able to direct the Winter Match, but there seemed to be some interest in having this tournament in conjunction with the Chess Clinic. Forty-six players played in the Winter Match. Pierre Indian Learning Center stayed overnight in Sioux Falls and all 29 players competed in the Winter Match. Eleven players finished the tournament with perfect 2-0 scores: Louis Horton, Dan Merchant, Dustin Krell, Ilia Nossov, Kurt Carlson, Kari Rivers, Sam Waters, Ian Grundstrom, Brant Abeln, Peter Thomas, and Robert Martin. The director altered Ralph's pairing system in order to allow Pierre Indian Learning Center players to play more Sioux Falls players.

SIOUX FALLS EDGES MADISON IN CHESS DUEL

In the closest match yet between the two rival varsity chess powers, the combined Sioux Falls School District toppled Madison in the final game of the final round to post an 8 1/2- 7 1/2 come from behind victory. Sioux Falls took the early lead as their top board, Steve Cahill, outlasted Madison's fourth board, Matt Havlik, in a close contest. Second board, Ilia Nossov, also beat Madison's third board, John Bergan, in another close game. Mike Bergan, Madison's second board, overcame tough resistance by Ryan Daggitt to claim Madison's first victory of the day, but the big surprise of the first round was Madison's first board, Xiao Yu, drawing with Sioux Falls' fourth board, Dustin Krell. Yu was a queen up in material, but with less than a minute left on his clock he accepted a draw rather than risk losing on time.

The second round was a reversal of the first, as Mike Bergan and Yu garnered victories while John Bergan managed to play Cahill to a draw and even the score at 4 - 4. The third round was a repeat of the second, as Yu, and the elder Bergan won while John Bergan put Madison ahead for the first time, accepting a draw while a rook up in material but having only 13 seconds left on his clock. The score was 6 1/2 - 5 1/2 after three rounds. Going into the fourth and final round, things were looking good for Madison since they only needed two wins to claim the match. However, Krell beat Havlik and Daggitt beat John Bergan even though Bergan had declined a draw offer from Daggitt earlier in the game when Daggitt was down material. Mike Bergan won his fourth game of the day by dispatching Nossov with a cute combination and thereby earning top individual honors. This left Yu and Cahill to

settle things on the top board, with Yu being favored because of his higher rating. As white, Yu played the Blackmar-Deimer gambit, hoping to gain a tactical advantage, but Cahill was equal to the occasion, playing the first thirty moves without relinquishing the gambit pawn. As Yu ran low on time, his position crumbled under the patient, irresistible pressure against his king, and Cahill snatched the victory for the visitors. The J-V match was a different story, as Anthony Vicino, Joe Waters, Isaac Gerdes and Jordan Gerdes mopped up on the hapless Madison team, winning all sixteen games. The next Chess event will be the Eye Open, held on February 27 and 28 at the DSU Trojan Center. Madison will defend its state titles in both the Jr. High and Sr. High divisions on March 20th in Sioux Falls.

Sioux Falls Home Schoolers Sweep Flandreau!

Sioux Falls Home School Association swept through the 4th Flandreau Indian School Chess Club Tournament much in the way that Madison did last year. This time the Home School won or share all 3 team titles. The numbers were the second lowest in the events history. Missing from last years tournament was the Pierre Indian Learning Center and Estelline. These two teams made up all of the Elementary Division in last year's tournament.

In addition, last year Madison brought 8 players including all 3 Bergan boys. This year only John played in the HS Section and Madison brought three players. Roosevelt brought three players and nine Home Schoolers played.

The play was better than I have seen in some of these events. Pre-tournament favorite John Bergan was forced into a triple repetition of position against Home Schooler John Shrader in the first round. The second round saw Dustin Krell mated by Isaac Gerdes. As a result we saw two pre-tournament favorites, Dustin Krell and John Bergan playing each other on one of lower boards in the 3rd round. Dustin beat John this time getting his revenge for the game was snatched away from him by the directors ruling at the Sioux Falls-Madison VI Match. Isaac Gerdes proved that his win over Dustin was no fluke by drawing with Ryan Daggitt of Roosevelt. Joe Waters pushed his way into the top spot by beating home schoolers Jordan Gerdes and Daniel Haggar. Joe was now faced with a dilemma. Should he go to a birthday party or try to win the title? He chose to play chess. He and Isaac battled in a Ruy Lopez Exchange Variation in which both sides mistakenly took the e pawn. Isaac attacked Joe's kingside. Isaac finally dropped the exchange and resigned a move later when Joe unleashed an attack with his knight forking the queen and rook and threatening mate. Ryan and Dustin finished second and third with wins over Home Schoolers John Shrader and Daniel Haggar. The Home Schoolers won the team competition with a 2.5 point win over Roosevelt and Flandreau Indian School which tied for second with 6.5 points. Last years winner Madison finished fourth with 6 points.

Kurt Shrader finished 4-0 to win the Junior High division His wins included wins over Sam Waters and Kevin Caraway. The Home Schoolers swept this division. In the Elementary Division, David Waters and Taryn Gerdes each won two games to split the individual and team prizes.

MADISON REPEATS AS STATE HIGH SCHOOL CHAMPIONS

Madison took four of the top six places to repeat as State High School Team Champions. Xiao Yu, Michael Bergan, John Bergan and Matthew Havlik all finished with four points to finish three points ahead of Sioux Falls Washington in the team standing. The last round saw a top board meeting between the state's top rated juniors, Mark Knudson of Sioux Falls Washington (sent South Dakota junior champion and 1995 State High School champion) and Mississippi scholastic champion. Mark won and will represent South Dakota in the Arnold Denker Tournament of High School Champions in Reno, Nevada in August. Madison entered the last round 2 points ahead of Washington.

Madison's top boards won 3 of 4 games including an upset by Matthew Havlik over Steve Cahill of Washington. Washington finished 2-2 in the last round. Flandreau Indian School was able to take third place. 7th grader John Bergan was able to take 4th place including a win over former State Champion TJ Likens. TJ took 5th place behind the Mark and three Madison players(Xiao Yu, Michael Bergan and John Bergan) Michael Bergan lost only to Mark Knudson while John Bergan suffered his lone loss to Steve Cahill The suprise of the tournament was probably Steven Smith of Riggs High School in Pierre. Playing in his first tournament, he scored four points with a last round win over former Junior Hi champion Ryan Daggitt of Sioux Falls Roosevelt. Sioux Falls O'Gorman started the tournament with eight players, but had only one active player by the end of the tournament. Thirty nine players played in the high school which made it the highest numbers for that tournament.

The suprise of the Junior High was that neither Ilia Nossov or Dustin Krell of Sioux Falls Edison won the tournament. These two were the highest rated coming into the tournament and Ilia seemed to be playing the best chess. Ilia lost to Daniel Hagggar in round 3 and finished in 4th place with four points. Dustin lost to eventual champion Anthony Vicino of Sioux Falls O'Gorman and finished 3rd with four points. Joe Waters was hot coming into this tournament having won the 4th Flandreau Indian Chess Club Tournament on March 13. Joe lost to Dustin in round 3, Daniel Hagggar in round 4 and Kurt Shrader in round 5 to finish with 2 points. Anthony Vicino's win was convincing with wins over 2nd place Daniel Hagggar and 3rd place Dustin Krell. Bradley Quilt of Pierre Indian Learning Center finished fifth, showing that his clock winning performance at the Eye Open Reserve Section was no fluke. In Junior Hi team competition, Sioux Falls Home School Association beat Pierre Indian Learning Center 14-11 to take the title. Kurt Shrader of Sioux Falls Home School Association who won the Flandreau Indian School Junior High division also finished with four points. Dustin and Ilia did produce enough points to win a third place team trophy for Sioux Falls Edison.

When the Gerdes decided to play in the Elementary division on March 13, it meant that they and the Home School Association were the odds on favorites to win the Elementary School Divison. They did not disappoint with both Isaac and Jordan Gerdes finishing a perfect 5-0. Isaac won several games in less than ten moves including his last round win over "wunderkind" Sam Waters Sioux Falls Mark Twain

provided the margin of victory. The SDCA mandated playoff of ties for 1st was enforced and Isaac beat Jordan in the one game playoff. Sioux Falls Home School Association needed all of the Gerdes points to hold off Sioux Falls Mark Twain and the Pierre Indian Learning Center for the Team Title. Isaac's win over Sam in the last round Pierre Indian Learning Center tied with Mark Twain, but won the second place trophy on tiebreak. Three players had four points and finished in following order on tiebreak: 3rd Place Ba Nguyen of Sioux Falls Longfellow; 4th Place Steven Blubaugh of Sioux Falls St.Lambert's and Brant Abeln of Sioux Falls Mark Twain in 5th Place.

This year we inaugurated a primary division. Fourteen players played in this section including seven girls from Pierre Indian Learning Center. The winner was Nate Holman of Sioux Falls All City Elementary(ACE) Sioux Falls Mark Twain won the team trophy and three of its players finished in the top five places. 2nd Place Alex Rasmussen, 4th Place Scott Munce, 5th Place David Waters. Sioux Falls Home School Association finished second in the team competition led by 3rd place winner Andrew Glader.

The numbers were somewhat lower than last year (119 compared to 136). Still the competition seemed stronger. The additional round allowed for decisive last round games in all section except Elementary where the Gerdes were forced to playoff for the title. The players competed for thirty-eight different teams. We had new players from Lower Brule, Rapid City, Pierre and many new schools in Sioux Falls. Madison sent thirteen players, Pierre Indian Learning Center twenty-two, Sioux Falls Mark Twain twelve, the Sioux Falls Home School Association seventeen players, Flandreau Indian School, six players and Sioux Falls O'Gorman, the host school had ten players.

We have Jud Bergan of Madison, Glen Eide and the staff of Pierre Indian Learning Center, Greg Waters and Jack Bier who work with Sioux Falls Mark Twain, Shawn DeMarrias, the coach of Flandreau Indian School, Mark Gerdes and Don Haggard and all of the parents of the Sioux Falls Home School Association, and Sam Ogdie of Sioux Falls O'Gorman. We would like to thank all of the persons who assist with chess clubs and all of the teachers who sponsor these clubs. Without these persons many of the persons who play in the schools would not play chess.
