NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL RETROSPECTIVE 1999 National High School Championship

De and David Knudson and the Sioux Empire Chess Foundation organized one of the best National High School Chess Tournaments ever in Sioux Falls. While I would have been happy with 500-700 kids, 943 chess players actually registered for the tournament. This total included 71 from South Dakota and 43 from Sioux Falls. Sixteen played in the Open Division, thirteen in the U1300 Division and forty-two played in the U1000 Division. Top finishers from South Dakota included Xiao Yu of Madison (who won a class trophy) and Mark Knudson of Sioux Falls who finished both finished with 5 points in the open section. Peter Schoen of Pierre and David Likens of Rapid City who finished with 3.5 points in the U1300 Division and Steven Smith of Pierre who finished with 5 points in the U1000 Division. The Pierre Indian Learning Center did the best of the South Dakota teams finishing 27th in the U1000. Division. Many South Dakotans volunteered their time to help with the tournament. Among the volunteers were Don Haggar, Greg and Kathy Waters, Kurt Carlson, Martin Waldner, John Wathier, Jack Bier, Kari Rivers, David Kerkhove, Karen Hermanson, Robert Daggitt, Nathan and Teri Holman, Mark Gerdes, Clarence Kieffer, John Gavin, Patrick Steele, and Dave and De Knudson of Sioux Falls, Lyle Hanson and Jerry Bergan of Watertown, Tim Paintner of Vermillion, Jud Bergan and June Lu of Madison, Dan Merchant of Brookings, and Alan Kingsley of Pierre. Among those on the tournament staff were David and De Knudson of Sioux Falls, organizers, Terry Likens of Rapid City, section chief U1000 section, Jill Likens, Rapid City, special assistant, Steve Haataja, head of backroom pairings, U1000 section and Wes Schmidt, Sioux Falls, assistant U1000 section chief. I have probably forgotten someone, sorry. You all put on a great show and made Sioux Falls proud. Especially Dave and De Knudson who brought the tournament to Sioux Falls and made it one of the best tournaments I have ever seen.

This is your official notice of the SDCA annual meeting which will take place at 8:00am on June 13, 1999 in the Missouri Wind Room, Radisson Cedar Shore Resort, Oacoma, South Dakota. Harry Overholtzer plans to introduce a code of conduct for the SDCA.

In fact, I hope that all entries to chess tournaments can be handled in a similar fashion to heighten interest in the particular event. Thanks, Dan, for taking over this large task for SDCA. Also, I'd like to thank Mark Derby in Vermillion who generously created and maintained the site through the University of South Dakota for the past couple years. We have all appreciated your efforts.

Think about spending a weekend in the Black Hills on May 22-23 and playing in the Western South Dakota Open. The four-round Swiss will be held at the West River Electric Association. Terry Likens is directing that event and is looking for more chess players.

The South Dakota Team Tournament is June 12-13 at the Cedar Shores Resort in Oacoma--same site as last year. Please organize a four person team immediately and send in your entry to Terry Likens. It would be great to have even more teams than last year!

Please note that the annual meeting of the SDCA is that Sunday at 8 a.m. I have enjoyed being your president, but it is time for new leadership. Please consider stepping up to the plate and running for an office in the SDCA. Our membership will only get stronger with new leaders. I need to devote more time to my game! Also, mark your calendar for July 17-18 for the SD Closed at Cedar Shores.

Finally, the Governor's Cup is scheduled for Sept. 10-12 at the Sioux Falls Convention Center. We will need more chauffeurs to take GM's to schools before and after the event and possibly people to house GM's during the event. Please let me know if you are interested in helping with either of these projects. GM's Shabalov, Yermolinsky, and Palatnik are planning to attend as well as IM John Donaldson, but we expect even more GM's and IM's to attend the Fourth Annual Governor's Cup. Thanks again for allowing me to lead you these past couple years. It has been my privilege. Our family has learned so much from all of you.
