SCHOLASTIC TO MOVE TO RAPID CITY IN 2002

The SDCA voted to accept a bid from Eric Abrahamson to move the South Dakota State Scholastic to Rapid City in 2002. This vote is a tribute to what Eric has done to make Rapid City a chess oasis. This will be the first change of location since 1994. The Scholastic Committee also voted to change the last two rounds of the High School Section to Game in 75 minutes. Several proposals for a separate team and individual tournament, a 2 day tournament, mandatory team splitting and rules regarding pairing of teammates were deferred to another day.

The Scholastic will be at the Sioux Falls Arena for 2001 thanks to the Sioux Empire Chess Foundation. It is hard to gauge what will occur in the 2001 Scholastic. The Sioux Falls Home Schoolers appear to be the team to beat in 2001 High School Section. Three players from last years Junior High Champions will be playing in the High School Division. The Home Schoolers won the Governors Cup High School Section. and the Winter Open Reserve Section. The Lincoln High team lost Goran Petrovic and gained Joe Waters . Its performance in the City indicate

that this team cannot match last year's team. Madison which finished second last year will return Michael Bergan and John Bergan, but not much else. Sioux Falls Roosevelt could be a factor if Ryan Daggitt and Ilia Nossov play with Ingmar Kaden. Three former champions, Michael Bergan, Mark Knudson and David Likens return. Other players who might win the State Title include Steve Cahill, Dan Wright, Isaac Gerdes, Daniel Haggar and Ingmar Kaden. Both St. Thomas More and Rapid City Stevens should do well. The former needs a full team and the latter must decide whether to play in High School. Five time state champion, Flandreau Indian School will return to the State Tournament after a one year absence. They have a new coach .

The Junior High Division depends on whom the Home Schoolers put in this division. With Nick Truelson and the Home Schoolers won the Veterans Day Junior High Division, the Sioux Falls City Scholastic Junior High and the Winter Open Reserve Section. But without Nick, the Home Schoolers could not win at the Governors Cup or the Black Hills Scholastic. Jordan Gerdes South Dakota Junior runner-up

who played in the High School Division of the Governors Cup and Veterans Day Scholastic has preregistered for the Junior High Division for Sioux Falls Home School. Also playing for Sioux Falls Home School are Jenna Haggar, Peter Glader and Ruth Glader. This team is certainly the favorite. Pierre Indian Learning Center has improved its play in the Junior High Section. It finished second at the Veterans Day Scholastic, won Winter Open Beginners Section, 1st at the Black Hills Scholastic Rapid City Southwest which finished 1st at the Governor's Cup Junior High, 3rd at the Veterans Day Scholastic and 2nd at the Black Hills Scholastic will also be a factor. If Rapid City Stevens plays K-9 it could do well since it finished second in the Governors Cup K-9. The only Sioux Falls school which could be a factor is Sioux Falls O'Gorman Junior High which did not show up at the City Scholastic and failed to show up at State last year.

In the elementary section we can expect Sioux Falls Mark Twain to field a good team led by Sam and David Waters and Scott Munce. They took second at the Winter Open Beginner Section. Sioux Falls Home

School will do fine if Jordan Gerdes play elementary. With Jordan playing and Southwest Middle School finished behind Sioux Falls Home School at the Veterans Day School and finished 1-2 at the Black Hills Scholastic where the Home Schoolers did not field a full team. We will have to whether Pierre and Southwest can beat Home School when it features a full team.

In the primary section ,PILC won at Taryn Gerdes, Andrew and Phillip Glader , Zach Truelson and Katie Shrader the Home Schoolers make a very formidable team. Ex-Mark Twainers Kevin Askew, Eric Brandt and Brandon Griesse make up a team at Sioux Falls Memorial Middle School that should do well. Pierre Indian Learning Center and Rapid City

One intriguing story is the possibility that Sioux Falls Home School Association will sweep every section. Last year they took every division but the High School Division and finished third in the High School. This year Home School has teams in every section which could win their sections championship. We shall see.

The tournament was played in an atrium with a skylight. The atrium contained two fishponds with large carp and many turtles and an aviary. The tournament attracted nearly 90 players playing in 3 divisions. Ten of the 28 players in the Open were from outside Sioux Falls. The pre-tournament favorite Nels Truelson was unable to find wins against Mark Knudson and

2ND ANNUAL SIOUX FALLS CHESS CLASSIC

Scott and Jodie Ponwith decided to repeat their successful tournament for unrated players. This year's tournament took place at the Christ the King Elementary Gym in Sioux Falls. One hundred forty two players registered for the tournament and one hundred twenty two persons played at least one game. This year's tournament did not allow rated players to participate since last year's two players with ratings under 500 won their sections. Scott and Jodi Ponwith obtained additional sponsorship this year from Cracker Barrel, McDonalds, Wakefield Family Chiropractic, Giggleebee's Lewis Drug, Sam's Club, Walmart, Pizza Hut, Skyforce, and Thunder Road who provided door prizes for the tournament

The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation donated trophies and medals and USCF memberships for the first and second place winners in each section. The Ponwiths sold pop and candy during the tournament. In order to avoid the problem with onsite registration Scott offered free pop to any persons who preregistered. One hundred twelve people preregistered so only thirty persons registered onsite. Twenty persons who preregistered did not show up. Scott dealt with this problem by pairing persons without opponents against each other much as is done in the National Scholastic Tournaments so that everyone would have a game.

The tournament rules called for persons helping with the tournament to confirm checkmates, escort winners to mark the pairing chart and answer any questions. We appreciate the work of Scott and Jodi Ponwith, Jim Ponwith, David Austin, Kurt and John Shrader, Nels Truelson, Stephan Billat and Greg Waters who assisted your tournament director with these duties

We were very pleased with the numbers of players who attended the tournament. Several schools including Terry Redlin and Christ the King sent eight or more players. These two schools are taught by Scott and Jodi Ponwith. Equally gratifying was the participation by large teams from JFK and Cleveland where there are no chess clubs. Hopefully, we will be able to provide a means for these persons to play on a regular basis.

The tournament was extended to five rounds to accommodate the additional players and produce a clear winner. Both sections produced clear winners. The team race in the K-6 section ended in a tie. Hopefully, we will see these players play rated chess in future years..
