GOODBYE TO ALL THAT

When the game between Mark Knudson and Ingmar Kaden ended and Mark became the first three time state high school champion, an era had ended in South Dakota scholastic chess. Both Mark and I were at the first state scholastic championship held in Sioux Falls in 1994. In 1993, Marty LaRoche reported that only two players had showed up in Aberdeen for the State Scholastic Championship. We have no records of

the event. Marty was not willing to hold the event in Aberdeen in 1994. I reluctantly scheduled the Scholastic to take place at the same time as the Sioux Falls Open because I was able to get 2 rooms at that time.

We had no idea who might show up at the Scholastic. We were lucky. to have Joe Gentry at Flandreau Indian School, Sam Ogdie at Sioux Falls O'Gorman and Harry Everhart at Artesian-Letcher who brought players to the event. Even though the numbers were only 22 it was a success compared to the previous year.

I needed help from De Knudson, Jeff Barth, and Kurt Carlson that day to register the players while I paired the first round of the Sioux Falls Open. Flandreau Indian School started its run of four straight state championships that day and a fifth grader from John Harris, Mark Knudson won his first state championship, the state elementary championship. The championship was held once more at Augustana, once at Sioux Valley Hospital, four times at Sioux Falls O'Gorman and in 2001 at the Sioux Falls Convention Center..

The event would grow from 22 in 1994 to 139 in 2000. The biggest The Home Schoolers won the

single force in the increase in scholastic chess was the participation by Pierre Indian Learning Center in 1997. Their participation raised the number from 35 in 1996 to 79 in 1997. Pierre came to us thanks to Annie Henry receiving information from Dan Heidinger a Mitchell chess player on the State Scholastic. Flandreau Indian School would win four state titles over that period. An event sponsored by Harry Everhart in Madison would bring the Bergans back to South Dakota chess in 1995. At its height Madison would dominate these championships in 1998 and 1999. Its club was the most active in South Dakota. Jud Bergan was able to scrape a team together 2000 which finished second and his son, Michael won his state title, but Madison did not play in 2001.. Artesian-Letcher would leave the chess scene after 1996 after winning 4 state team titles in 1994 and 1995.

The Sioux Falls Home School Association entered chess in 1998 and was able to immediately impact South Dakota chess. Isaac and Jordan Gerdes tied for the Elementary Championship with John Bergan.

Elementary Championship that day

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and have won four straight elementary championships. The past two years the home schoolers have won three of four state championships.

What things will I remember from the eight years that the State Championship has been in Sioux Falls. I will remember having to stagger the rounds of the 1994 Elementary championship because I had paired it Swiss instead of a round robin. Being lucky in 1995 that Jon Jorgenson of North Dakota did not win the State High School because he missed a round.. Watching Nick Randall win a game in 1995 despite being a queen down.. Sitting with George Fauske as he waited for his grandson, Nick Randall. Setting up for the chess tournament with De Knudson and Sam Ogdie at O'Gorman on the Friday before the tournaments.

Turning off the team pairing restriction after realizing that the computer wanted to pair 4-0's against 0-4. Being disgusted with state champions who degraded their opponents while they played. Being proud of the quality of play that South Dakota had achieved while watching Mark Knudson play Michael Bergan in 2000. Enjoying the enthusiasm of the Patrick Henry team in giving David Likens when he beat his opponent from Whittier to give Patrick Henry the State Title. I have heard that Casey Swanson of Patrick Henry slept with that trophy for a week before giving it to the school. Lastly, I remember my son, Aaron, lying on the table as he played his game with Amanda Brandt in the last round.

As I said at the beginning Mark Knudson won his first state title in 1994 at the first Sioux Falls State Scholastic. It is fitting that Mark won his last state championship as the State Championship moves to Rapid City.

I wish Jill, Terry and Erik good

luck for next year. I hope to be there to assist them in their efforts

THE NEW RATING SYSTEM

The USCF recently changed its
rating system. The basic system
was developed by Dr. Arpad Elo in
the 1950's. The idea of the system
was to create a statistical model
which would predict the result
between two chess players who
had established rating. The system
had its flaws. At its limits the
system lost its predictive value.
Dr. Elo once stated that the system
had no predictive value for players
rated below 1200. Over time the

system has a deflationary effect on
the players at the top of the rating
system. The USCF raised the
ratings of active players by 100
points in the period from 1979-
1982. It also tried bonus points i.e.
adding points to players who
achieved exceptional results and
feedback points which gave points
to players who played the players
who received bonus points. In my
article comparing the Governor's
Cup to Gerry Mortimer's Sioux
Falls Opens from 1979-1981 the
effect of this rating inflation is
clear. All of the players that I
studied had significant rating
increase. In the nineties we have
seen another deflation of rating.
The following chart shows what
has happened to South Dakota
adult players ratings since
1992. Most of their ratings show
significant decrease from their high
ratings in the last nine years.
Several like myself have escaped
this rating loss only through
inactivity.

Dr. Glickman recently
developed a system which would
reinflate ratings for the USCF.
According to USCF the revised
rating system includes "...the new
formulas for rating provisional
players, varying K, multiple
passes, and
bonus/feedback.. Finally, for a two-
year period, starting with the next
rating run and continuing through
the 2002 annual rating, the
threshold for bonus points will
change from 16 x the square-root
of the number of games (minimum
of 3 games) to 10 x the square root
of the number of game. The effect
of this change should
approximately re-inflate the ratings
to where they were in 1996 when
floors were changed. The impact of
changing

he multiplier on the threshold from 16 to 10 would on average, taking the example of an 1800 player, augment the chances of that player qualifying for bonus points from 6% to 17%". Recent results from the Winter Open, some sections of the Veterans Day Open and Black Hills Scholastic illustrate how much the scholastics have gained. The adult sections of the Winter Open did not show similar gains. So as usual the kids will get rating points while us old fellows will continue to have a hard time holding our ratings. Since the kids at the lower end of the rating spectrum make up the majority of the rated players, this should reinflate the rating system.

HOME SCHOOLERS DOMINATE AGAIN AT SOUTH DAKOTA SCHOLASTIC

The South Dakota Chess Association sponsored the South Dakota State Scholastic Chess Championship. The chess tournament was held on March 17, 2001 at the Sioux Falls Convention Center. One hundred twenty-six players representing forty-seven schools played in the tournament. The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation paid for the rooms. Mark Knudson of Sioux Falls Washington who won the High School Individual Championship for the 3rd time will represent South Dakota at the Arnold Denker Tournament of High School Championships was the Middle School Individual Champion was the first female winner of a South Dakota Scholastic Chess Champion, Next years state scholastic chess championship will be held at the South Dakota School of Mines in Rapid City on March 16, 2002.

As predicted the Sioux Falls Home School Association dominated again the team competition at the South Dakota Scholastic Championships in Sioux Falls. The only real question was whether they would win all four sections. Last year the Home Schoolers won the primary,

elementary and junior hi sections of the State Scholastic. This year, they won team titles in all but primary division. In addition they won ten of twenty individual trophies and one individual title. The team race was not close in any of these divisions.

The Home Schoolers had three of the top six positions in the High School Division. Lincoln Hi finished second this year after winning last year. Madison which won in 1998 and 1999 and finished second in 2000 did not return. Five time champ Flandreau Indian School which had been absent in 2000 returned to the State Championships.

Mark Knudson became the first person to win the State High School Individual Championship three times. He won in 1995, 1999 and 2001 He will represent South Dakota in the Arnold Denker Tournament of High School Champions held at Framingham, Massachusetts August 5-10, 2001. Mark had a shaky start. Kevin Caraway had a mate against Mark but overlooked it allowing Mark to draw by triple-repetition of position. Once he got past Brandon Coyle, Mark took care of two of his closest competitors, Steve Cahill and Ingmar Kaden to win another state HS championship. The biggest sunrise of the tournament was Kurt Shrader who beat Joe Waters and drew with Ingmar Kaden and David Likens. Next year will see a changing of the guard as Mark Knudson Steve Cahill and, David Likens and John Shrader all graduate. St. Thomas More High School of Rapid City finished third in the teams competition. Hopefully, it and Rapid City Stevens will be more competitive next year when the

tournament will be held at the South Dakota School of Mines in Rapid City.

Jenna Haggard who won the K-9 Division is the first female to win a South Dakota Scholastic Individual Championship. Her closest competition was other Home Schoolers. She beat fellow home schoolers, Jordan Gerdes and Peter Glader in the last two rounds. Home Schoolers took four of five trophies. All of this without the addition of Nicholas Truelson who played in the Elementary Division. There was distinctively West River tinge to this division as Pierre Indian Learning Center took second team, while Rapid City Stevens and Rapid City Southwest Middle School tied for third place. All of these teams will be back next year Jenna Haggard and Peter Glader will move up to High School to strengthen that team.

The Home Schoolers showed a similar dominance in the Elementary School Division winning 5 of the top 9 positions. They have now won four consecutive state championships/ Sam Waters was able to beat Nick Truelson again and gain revenge for last years defeat and win the Elementary Championship. Sam has won fifteen straight games this year, winning Winter Open U1200 Division, South Dakota Elementary Division and Mid America Elementary Championship. Mark Twain finished second while the ex-Mark Twain players at Memorial Middle School tied for third place with Pierre Indian Learning Center.

Ryan Brandt won his third straight primary section. (Veterans Day Scholastic, Sioux Falls City Scholastic and South Dakota Primary Championship. Pierre Indian Learning Center broke the

dominance of the Home Schoolers by taking first place in the Primary Section. They took three of the top four places. Ryan Brandt and Dylan Powell led Mark Twain to second Place finish The Home Schoolers did pick up a trophy in this section third place..

Overall the total of 126 was

down from the last years total of 141.. We still have a very narrow base: Sioux Falls Home School Association 23 Pierre Indian Learning Center 22 Sioux Falls Lincoln 11;Mark Twain.9 Pierre and Lincoln pay for their players entries thanks to the work of Glenn Eide at PILC and Phyllis Schrag and John Wathier at Sioux Falls Lincoln while Mark Gerdes, Nels Truelson, and Don Hagggar all make sure that the Home Schoolers are out in force. Greg Waters and Jack Bier kept Mark Twain going despite losses to Memorial Middle School where the Askews have started a program.. Rapid City brought 22 players to the tournament in large part due to the work of Eric Abrahamson and Dr.Kumar.. We hope to see many more of them in Rapid City next year. Twenty players who attended Scott Ponwith's Sioux Falls Chess Classic played in this tournament. We have Scott Ponwith and Mark Gerdes to thank for this event. Scott brought these people to chess. Mark sent them an invitation to play in South Dakota Scholastic Championships. Thanks to all of the parents and children who attended this event. My congratulations to Mark Knudson and David Likens who played in 7 State Chess Championships and Steve Cahill and Duane Martin who have played in 5 State Chess Championships. We hope to see you in Rapid City at the South Dakota School of Mines on March 16,2002 for the 2002 South Dakota State Scholastic Chess Championship.
