RETENTION OF MEMBERSHIP

One frequent topic on the chess politics web site is the relation between the adult members and the scholastic members. The complaint is heard that the scholastic members do not carry their share of the USCF dues since they pay only \$13-\$20 while adult members pay \$40. Another complaint is that while regular adult members represent only 29 percent of the total membership they pay a majority of the USCF operational budget while

scholastic and youth categories which make up over 50 percent of the Federation do not carry their full weight. The last argument is that we use the incentive of lower membership dues to bring in scholastic members who drop out after one or two years. While we do not enough to retain adult members who typically are USCF members for more than two years. At present we have grown through scholastic chess. By having a scholastic championship we encouraged young players to play chess. Some may argue that the level at which most scholastic players play is not at a level which will serve them well when they become adults. We have had scholastic players who are competitive at adult level.

In recent years we have concentrated on scholastic chess.

because the most active organizers were interested in organizing scholastic chess, because without the scholastic chess component most of the tournaments we have would have fewer than 30 players. In addition the organization which puts on the Governor's Cup. The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation is dedicated to the support of scholastic chess. I have charted the South Dakota membership based on the 12-01 rating list on the USCF website. The USCF has been tracking the memberships listed on the website since 1992. I have listed the total memberships listed on the website, I listed those members who have played a rated game which was included in 12/99 rating list to recognize activity. next I have listed life members.(all of these members are also adult members),I have listed members with current memberships on the USCF website and lastly adult members. The purpose of this table to determine to what extent we are retaining adult and scholastic member Most of our USCF members are scholastic members, but most of the players

who participate in our SDCA tournaments and are members are adults most of whom have been USCF members for 20 or more years. Of the 76 adult members there is core of 20-25 adult players who consistently show up for tournaments. Of the 21 Life Members only 11 are active members. Clearly we must do something to increase the core of adult members. We can do this either by convincing scholastic players to continue playing as adults or by recruiting adult players. According to USCF

membership numbers furnished to Pete Nixon , as of November 2,2001,South Dakota had 23 life members,69 regular members,2 senior members,1 sustaining member,55 youth members,216 scholastic members,6 family members and 5 Junior tournament players.The total head count for South Dakota is 372 with 3 affiliate members and 1 state chapter members. The total membership count is 383.

Chess is a unique competition.
There is no cheering crowd. There

is rarely a high five or victory dance after a victory (except in the K-3 sections of scholastic tournaments). No cheerleaders to keep the fans enthusiastic. And trash talking your opponent will get you a warning from the tournament director. As we all

know, chess is about logic, strategy and critical thinking. It is about making the best move. It is about taking your time to find that one move from which your opponent cannot recover. And it is about quiet contemplative thought.
Organizing chess

tournaments are quite the opposite. Those involved in the organization of the quiet peaceful tournaments know of the chaos that occurs in the days and hours preceding any tournament. Organizers are part PT Barnum, part accountant, part host, part errand boy and part nervous parent. There is ongoing communication with on site organizers, team coaches, tournament directors and of course other nervous parents. The promotional piece is nerve racking (e.g. four days until the tournament and we still only have 7 entries). The responsibility of making sure that everyone who should know about the tournament actually receives the information is often overwhelming. The morning of any tournament is the worst. Tournament room setup, computer glitches and late players are only part of the worries. I could go on and on.

Where does this bring us?

My answer is simple: Players (who I understand are quiet and contemplative by nature) must communicate! I have a mailing list of over 300 players. Yet my e-mail list is only about 110 names in length. I would love to have the e-mail address of every chess player in South Dakota. If you do not routinely receive e-mails from me, please send your e-mail address to me at NMG8860@AOL.com I let the tournament organizers know what was good and what was bad about the tournament. We want to put on good tournaments, but need feedback as to what the players liked or did not like. Ask questions. Every chess tournament has a flyer and registration form. On that form there is always a telephone number or e-mail address. It is my experience that people would rather guess at the answer to a

question they have, than to call or e-mail the event organizer.

Pre-register early. It helps us to plan the event properly. We can ensure that boards and sets are available for all players. We can make sure that there are enough concessions available. Pre-registration also helps the tournament director to start the tournament on time.

Campbell was the youngest of 114 players who came from around the state to compete in the tournament held at the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology on Saturday, November 10.

The Pierre Indian Learning Center, which offers a strong chess program for its resident students, took first place in

the Primary (K-3) division team competition, followed by South Park Elementary in second and Pinedale Elementary in third. Individual honors went to Patrick Wind, of the Pierre Indian Learning Center, who went undefeated to take first place.

In the Elementary (K-5) division, the nationally ranked Sioux Falls Home School team took first place, sweeping the top three spots. Home Schoolers Andrew Glader and Jonathan Sax both went undefeated to finish as co-champions. The Pierre Indian Learning Center and Corral Drive Elementary tied for second place.

The Middle School (K-8) division attracted the most competitors. The Sioux Falls Home School team and Southwest Middle School battled for first with the Home Schoolers pulling away in the final two rounds for the championship. The Pierre Indian Learning Center finished in third place. Home Schooler Nicholas Truelson captured the individual title, winning all five of his games.

The High School competition (K-12) featured a battle between Riggs High School in Pierre and Rapid City Stevens. Riggs took top honors. Stevens finished second, and the Sioux Falls Home School team placed third. Daniel Wright of Pierre won the individual trophy by winning four games and drawing one.

The Veteran's Day Scholastic was sponsored by the South Dakota School of Mines & Technology, the Children's Science Center, the Southwest Middle School Chess Club and the Stevens High School Chess Club.
