chess. Two additional tournaments were held this year, the Holiday Tournament in Sioux Falls and the PILC Scholastic Chess Tournament. The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation is now organizing all but one tournament in Sioux Falls. Glenn Eide finally got people to Pierre by organizing a tournament at the Pierre Indian Learning Center. Eric Abrahamson even organized a bus for the Rapid City players to this event.

Most of the success of chess in South Dakota is due to work of three people, Mark Gerdes, Eric Abrahamson and Glenn Eide. The organizational efforts of these men has brought chess to South Dakota on a regular basis.

As result, chess has improved in Sioux Falls, Rapid City and Pierre. In Sioux Falls, Isaac Gerdes, Nick Truelson and Daniel Hagggar now play on a regular basis in adult

tournaments. In Pierre, Riggs has developed a team which can contend for the State High School title. The Pierre Indian Learning Center has developed players at the primary and elementary level whose play has improved due to amount and continuity of play. This year we saw play improve in Rapid City where quality is now catching up with the quality of players.

The Home Schoolers hope to sweep all sections of the State Scholastic this year. Last year they won all sections, but the K-3 section. They return most of the players who won the High School section last year. Riggs appears to be the only impediment in their way. Many of the Rapid City Southwest Middle Schoolers have moved up to Stevens and Central. and should do well. Last year Stevens 9th graders played in the Junor High

section., but this is not allowed this year, because of the switch to a K-8. This change is somewhat K-8 with Nick Truelson, Tim Sax and Jordan Gerdes leading the way. Rapid City Southwest will probably finish second based on their performances this year.

Pierre Indian Learning Center has its best chances in the Elementary and Primary Sections. They beat the Home Schoolers in the Primary section of the Governors Cup and Sioux Falls City Scholastic going head

to head. The question is whether the Home Schoolers can find a fourth player. The Home Schoolers have not played as an Elementary team since the Sioux Falls City Scholastic. It appears that Zachary Truelson, Taryn

Gerdes and Andrew Glader who led SFHS to its first Primary win two years ago will provide the impetus for the 5th straight elementary title for the Home Schoolers.

The only thing missing at this state tournament will be Sioux Falls players.

I have always said that Sioux Falls players do not travel well. As a result we will only see the Home Schoolers and certain individuals whose parents are willing to drive them to Rapid City. See you there at the biggest state scholastic tournament in state history. WDS

to Dallas, Texas for the K–12 National Chess Tournament. The tournament turned out to be a rush of mental stresses and challenges for all involved.

K–12 Nationals is a grade specific tournament that was very well run. Because it is grade specific, teams are made up of only three players (a team may have many players, but only the three highest scoring players count toward the team total). Nels & I knew prior to the tournament that we had a distinct disadvantage because our 7th grade team had only three players, meaning each player must have a strong tournament. Comparatively, Christian Brothers School of New Orleans with seven players and Shea Middle School of Phoenix with six players were pre-tournament favorites. Our three-player team of Nick Truelson, Jordan Gerdes and Isaac Gerdes started the tournament with each player winning his match. By the end of the third round, the team was tied for first with 7.5 points (Isaac 3, Nick 2.5, Jordan 2). A successful fourth round left the boys in second place, only one-half point behind, going into Sunday's final two rounds.

As Sunday started, we knew that the fifth round would be difficult, as both Jordan and Nick were playing black against higher rated opponents. The tournament stayed tight, as the first place team could only match Isaac's fifth round win, with one point. That left us one-half point behind going into the final round. We assumed that it would take 2.5 points in the final round to win the national title. It seemed like a lot to ask, but pairings were in our favor.

Tension built as we learned that Jordan was behind in his game to a lower rated player. Isaac and Nick both had tough games going, and a loss by Jordan would be catastrophic to any title chances. Another report, Jordan is further behind. Resign

Black Hills Scholastic Chess Tournament Crowns City Champions by Eric Abrahamson

North Middle School eighth grader Alex Young is not the loquacious type, but his smile says everything. This Saturday, Young was all smiles as he received the City Champion medal at the Black Hills Scholastic Chess Tournament held at Southwest Middle School. Young was among 116 students who competed in four divisions in this tournament - a warm-up to the state championship to be held in Rapid City on Saturday, March 9. Young and sixth grader Andrew Howard of West Middle School were both undefeated in the tournament, but Young took first place on the tie-breaks.

Meanwhile, the Southwest Middle School Eighth Grade team took first place in the middle school team competition, followed by the Pierre Indian Learning Center in second. The South Middle School and Southwest Middle School Sixth Grade teams tied for third, but the Southwest team took the trophy on tie-break points.

In the High School division, Sioux Falls seventh grader Nicholas Truelson played up and still managed to take first place with a record of four wins and one draw. Thomas Cleberg, a junior at Rapid City Central High School, placed second and earned the City Champion title. In the team competition, Rapid City Stevens High School triumphed. Central finished second, with the Black Hills Forest High School in third.

Among the younger competitors, forty-four students competed in the Elementary Division. Sioux Falls Home Schooler Zachary Truelson garnered first place, winning all five of his matches. David Grant of the Pierre Indian Learning Center took second on tie-breaks with Grandview Elementary's Thomas Tolman in third. Tolman received the City Champion medal. The Pierre Indian Learning Center took the team competition, narrowly defeating Grandview. Corral Drive Elementary squeaked past St. Elizabeth Seton to win the third place trophy.

Meanwhile, in the Primary division, Patrick Wind of the Pierre Indian Learning Center finished with four wins and a draw to capture first place. Ezra Stewart, a third-grader at Meadowbrook Elementary finished in second with four wins and one loss and took home the City Champion medal.
