SDCA summer schedule begins

We have reached the end of another scholastic season. Now we move on into the summer SDCA season which is mostly an adult world. Before we do we should pay tribute to the three men who brought us a very successful scholastic season: Mark Gerdes of Renner, Glen Eide of Pierre, Mark Derby of Vermillion and Eric Abrahamson of

Rapid City. They organized nearly every event held in the state from October to May. These events were

mainly scholastic events, but occasionally an open division was held where adults and adventurous scholastics would play.

The opens have attracted as many as 30 players and as few 12 players. Although Nels Truelson dominated these open events, his son, Nick Truelson tied with Randall Koeller for first place at the Sioux Falls Open and became the youngest Sioux Falls City Champion at 12 years of age.

Most of my predictions for the state scholastic came true. The turnout was the largest in South Dakota Scholastic chess history. Many from Sioux Falls including myself could not make it due to the weather. My congratulations to Terry, Jill and TJ and their crew of beanie extras for managing a tournament of this size. The Home Schoolers dominated the High School division with Daniel

Haggar beating Isaac Gerdes in a playoff game for first place. Daniel will represent South Dakota at the Tournament of High School Champions. The Home Schoolers were able to win the Elementary Division for the fifth straight year due to the dominance of Zach Truelson, Andrew Glader and Taryn Gerdes. They had to bring Caleb Glader up from their depleted K-3 team to bring their team to full strength. In K-3 Pierre won as I had predicted. Though who could have predicted a five way playoff for first. The big surprise was Rapid City Southwest Middle School beating Sioux Falls Home School Association in the Middle School Division. No one could have predicted this result. Alexander Young of Rapid City North won his third straight tournament with a

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perfect score. He later scored 4.5/7 at the K-8 Championship Division in representing them at the National High Championship in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. We should be proud of all of these young men and women.

Now the oldsters get to vie with these young guns for the SDCA summer prizes. The SD Teams will be held at Cedar Shores in Oacoma on June 22 and 23. The SDCA annual membership meeting will be held at 8:00am on June 23 at Cedar Shores. This is your official notice of that meeting. The SD Closed and Junior Championship will be held on July 13 and 14 at Cedar Shores in Oacoma.

THE SUNFISH CHESS TOURNAMENT

Eighth graders Danny Shen of Vermillion, SD and Greg Riker of Sioux City, IA found themselves swimming with sharks playing against seven adults in their section that consisted mostly of coaches and parents. Danny had great success while Greg learned some lessons. Greg's first lesson was taught by Mr. Shen and the subject was how to win in seven moves. The focus of the tournament was on the reserve section where former tadpoles could test the waters of a real tournament and get familiar with using a clock and writing down moves. There was a three way tie for first place with Camden Perez and Alex Larson of Vermillion along with Tom Koeller of Parkston. The first place winners went 3 and 1 with Alex winning his game against Tom, and Tom winning against Camden, and Camden beating Alex in the last round. Alex Larson, a member of the US Chess Federation, was the only undefeated player after three rounds and the only Vermillion player with experience in rated tournaments. Camden Perez, a Vermillion home schooler, has only been playing a couple of months and shows incredible promise. "I've never seen an eight year old take to the game like Camden has. He seems to have a natural skill to coordinate his pieces with other." said Vermillion Coach Mark Derby. "That with his accurate notation and ability to concentrate for long periods of time

⊕As I mentioned at the SF Open, the North Dakota Closed is now Open, or rather is now call the North Dakota Championship Tournament and is now open to all. The highest scoring North Dakota resident is crowned State Champion, and for the tenth year in row, that is Mike Sailor. It is held on the first weekend of May every year (if possible) in Bismarck. I played in it last weekend and scored 4.5/6. They run progressively slower time controls to get 4 games in on Saturday, with round 1 at Game/1, round 2 and 3 at Game/90 and rounds 4-6 at Game/2. Here is the crosstable if you would care to run it in our newsletter so that they can get a few more SD players there next year. As you can see, the rating of the competition isn't half bad. Where do we go from here? Let's prioritize!

There are so many things that are good in life. Spring has arrived. Baseball has started another season. My five year old daughter is learning to ride her bike. A twelve year old won the Sioux Falls Open. A chess team from South Dakota took second in the nation. It looks like possible record turnout for the team tournament on June 22-3 in Chamberlain. A little piece of my mind keeps wanting me to look back and check to see if there are any steamrollers gaining ground from behind. We do have issues that need to be addressed and focused on within the chess world of South Dakota. They are not all negative issues, as some are related to growth of chess. But there are things that require more than De Knudson, Eric Abrahamson and Wes Schmidt. We are going to need increased input of ideas and energy from more of our members if the growth and resurgence of chess is to continue.

1. Calendar- It is imperative in my home to have things marked on the calendar. I assume that there are hundreds of homes similar to mine, where if it is not marked on the calendar, it does not get done. We worked hard for the last two years to keep the calendar current on the web-page. We need to be planning the 2002-3 chess year and we will need input from many to put the information out for players to use.
2. Tournament announcements - I have worked diligently over the past two years to develop an e-mail system to notify players and coaches of upcoming tournaments and events. The biggest issue is that many people frequently change e-mail addresses. Please let me know of your current e-mail address if you have not been receiving these updates from me. My e-mail address is still NMG8860@AOL.com.
3. Standardizing some tournament issues. South Dakota Chess Assn (SDCA) and Sioux Empire Chess Foundation (SECF) need to work together to look at the calendar and determine who is running which tournaments (promoting and directing). The two organizations also need to look at standardizing some director fees. Tournament directors are the unsung heroes of chess and deserve to be treated in a fair and recognized manner.
4. Improving upon some of the growth that has occurred in certain regions. It has long been my contention that active parents make for good chess. One only needs to look at the chess success stories in South Dakota. Mark Knudson, Nick Truelson, Sam Waters and Isaac Gerdes have accomplished much, but only because their parents were interested. The Sioux Falls Home School team has been a power in S.D. for the last 3-4 years, because

of active and involved parents. Eric Abrahamson has helped stimulate tremendous chess growth in Rapid 5. Volunteers - De Knudson and myself have been asked by numerous schools to find a chess coach for their schools. We are lacking the volunteers to take on those duties. It is a lot to ask. But the rewards can be great. By next fall, I would like to see programs in Sioux Falls and most of the larger cities in South Dakota where a chess coach visits the school chess program at least once a month. But there are a lot of schools, so we need a lot of volunteers. If you are willing to give your time, contact De or myself. It is time to prioritize and capitalize on the current success. I hope that you will step forward and help chess to grow.

Southwest Middle School Stuns

Nationally Ranked Sioux Falls in State Scholastic Chess Championship

In a surprising upset at the South Dakota Scholastic Chess Championships in Rapid City on Saturday the Southwest Middle

City. We need to capitalize on the current success of chess in South Dakota and help it to grow. But that School Chess Team edged the nationally-ranked Sioux Falls Home School Team to win the state title. The victory highlighted a remarkable day for Rapid City players and teams.

The Sioux Falls team has been a growing powerhouse at the national level for several years now. Their seventh-grade team took second in the nation last December at the national grade-level championships held in Dallas, and they were heavy favorites to win the middle school state championship on Saturday. But several major upsets by seventh and eighth graders at Rapid City's Southwest Middle School, led by Zachary Abrahamson, James Kushman, Gabe Stewart, Sam Hopewell, and Justin Hicks combined to push Southwest's team ahead of Sioux Falls. The Pierre Indian Learning Center finished third.

Southwest's victory was aided by the remarkable success of eighth grader Alexander Young from North Middle School. Young's victories in the final rounds over two of Sioux Falls' strongest players – Jordan Gerdes and Timothy Sax – dropped the Home School team to second place. In the process, Young capped a year of dramatic improvement by winning the title of state middle school champion. Kevyn Zephier – a sixth grader from South Middle School – was also part of the 6-way tie at third place.

In other play, eighteen-year old Daniel Hagggar claimed first place in the high school division after a tie-breaker playoff with thirteen-year old Isaac Gerdes. Hagggar and Gerdes both play for the Sioux Falls Home School team. With his victory, Hagggar earned the right to compete in the national Arnold Denker Tournament of High School Champions to be held later this year in New Jersey. The Sioux Falls

will take work on the behalf of interested parents.

Home School team claimed four of the five top places in the high school division to win the state team title. Second place went to Rapid City Stevens High School – led by Jordan Hoff who tied for third - and third went to Rapid City Central – led by Zachary Young who tied for fifth. The Sioux Falls Home School team also walked away with the first place team trophy took first place in a narrow victory in the Elementary School division with 15.5 points. They were led by Zachary Truelson who finished the day undefeated with five victories to claim the title of state champion. Taryn Gerdes and Andrew Glader finished in the tie for third place. The Pierre Indian Learning Center took second with 15.0 points. They were led by David Grant, Anetha Thundershield and Leon Mitchell – each included in the 7-way tie for third place. Third place was won followed by Rapid City's Grandview Elementary in third with 14.5 points. Grandview was led by Matthew Almeida who finished in second place and Thomas Birgenheir who finished in the third place tie. Daniel Bickett of St Elizabeth Seton was the final player in the 3rd place tie.

Meanwhile, in the Primary Division, a five-way tie for first place in the individual competition had to be resolved with a playoff. The playoff included Patrick Wind (Pierre Indian Learning Center), Jonathan Sax and Austin Simon (Sioux Falls Home School), Ezra Stewart (Meadowbrook Elementary, Rapid City) and Sean Seefeldt (Grandview Elementary, Rapid City). The Pierre Indian Learning Center's Patrick Wind captured the top spot, helping to power his team to first as well in another tight team race with 12.5 team points. Rapid City's South Park Elementary took second with 11.5

team points - making a strong showing, edged Grandview for second

Elementary who took third place with 11.0 team points.

In all, more than 150 students, representing 30 schools from around the state, competed in the tournament, despite the weather on Friday that kept some East River teams from making the trip west. In the sixteen-year history of the state competition, this was the first state championship to be held in Rapid City. It was also the largest turnout for the state championship in history. The tournament was hosted by the South Dakota School of Mines & Technology and the South Dakota Chess Association.
