PIERRE HOSTS SUCCESSFUL STATE SCHOLASTIC

The Pierre Indian Learning Center held its first SDCA scholastic championship since the mid80s and this one was much more successful. There were one hundred thirty six players in attendance. Forty nine players from Pierre Indian Learning Center played in the tournament.

Elementary of Rapid City had eleven players at the tournament. Grand View took second in the Primary section

and third in elementary section

.Sioux Falls Home School was very efficient. It won three divisions: High School, Middle School and Primary with only fourteen players. Home Schoolers finished 1-2-3 in Primary, 1-5-6 in High School and 1-2-3-4-6 in Junior High. Isaac Gerdes won his first high school championship and his fourth championship in six years . Isaac has only lost one regular game in six years of scholastic championships.

Isaac is only an eighth grader and cannot represent South Dakota at the Arnold Denker Tournament of High School Champions. As a result Alden

Meeter of Sioux Falls Washington and Thomas Cleberg had a playoff to determine our representative. Thomas Cleberg of Rapid City Central High School won the playoff and will represent South Dakota at the Arnold Denker Tournament of High School Championships held in Los Angeles, CA August 3- August 8, 2003. Nicholas Truelson won his second championship this time at the Junior High Level. Jonathan Sax won Primary Section with a win over fellow Brandonite, Leland Murren in the last round. The Home Schoolers did not win the Elementary for the first time since 1998. They did not have any players in this division.

Flandreau Indian School returned to High School Division after a two year absence. while last years Last years surprise team Rapid City Southwest Middle School only fielded three players but still won the third place trophy in the Middle School Division. Sam Waters won his second Elementary championship winning a playoff over fellow Sioux Falls Mark Twain Elementary player, Ryan Brandt. They combined with Dylan Powell to finish second in the Elementary Division.

Next years tournament will be in Rapid City. Hopefully Rapid City will be able to match their record numbers of 2002. Our thanks to Glen Eide and Pierre Indian Learning Center for putting on a find tournament, to Terry and Jill Likens, Nels Truelson and Bob Wallace for directing the tournament in an efficient and professional manner.(even though Terry states that he was so busy running tournament that he does not what occurred in the tournament other than the results.) and Mark Gerdes, Larry Sax, and Eric Abrahamson without whose assistance the tournament would not have been possible..

Our thanks to Paul Roisen of Sioux City East Middle School, Randall Koeller and Darin Brink who organized the Parkston team and Mark Derby who coordinated the Vermillion entries. They helped to save this section when Pierre Indian Learning Center could not play in the tournament. Sioux City East Middle School beat Parkston for the team title while Akok Patel of Sioux City East Middle School won the individual title.

My thanks to Mark Gerdes who arranged the tournament at Sioux Vocation Services, and sold concessions to cover the rental for the tournament, to Tim Tobiasson of Silver Creek, Nebraska whose chess concession was a big hit. He awarded a chess CD for every upset in the tournament and to Sioux Vocational Services for renting us the site. Good sites are getting hard to get. Hopefully, next year's tournament will be bigger and better than ever.
