David and De Knudson rescued the Governor's Cup from oblivion this year. The 9th annual Governors Cup almost did not happen. De and David were not going to be in charge of this year's tournament, but took over after the committee which had been organized to raise money and run the tournament were unable to raise any money. This year's effort shows more than ever that we will have a hard time replacing the Knudsons. Dave raised over \$20,000 and De was able to bring in more titled players. The numbers for the Governors Cup were lowest ever, but since

many of the players in the Open had been paid to attend the overall monies may have been better. De was somewhat unhappy with the South Dakota numbers which were the fewest in Governors Cup history. She has already scheduled a date for the 10th Governors Cup, but no contract has been signed. An article on the tournament by John Donaldson is in the January 2005 Chess Life.

Four scholastic tournaments were held in the fall. The Sioux Empire Chess Foundation organized the Governor's Cup Scholastic and All City Chess Festival. Eric Abrahamson and Terry Likens organized the Veterans Day Scholastic. Numbers were up for the Governors Cup Scholastic, while the Veterans Day tournament and All City Scholastic saw declines. Attendance at these events was swelled by the participation of Pierre Indian Learning Center

and Rapid City Grandview Elementary. Sioux Falls Mark Twain returned to an activity with a new sponsor. The high school sections of these events was very low. Hopefully, this will be solved by State Tournament time.

Nels Truelson ran the AmericInn tournaments in Sioux Falls on December 4, 2004. This tournament had the highest attendance of any AmericInn tournament in South Dakota. Groups came from Luverne and Aberdeen. A Minnesota master named Franky Johnson who is attending Augustana won the tournament. Mark Derby has created several graphics for SDCA use.
