In the last bulletin available in our
files here in Pierre for 1977,
August, it states that the bulletin
has a new address, that being Emil
Knapp. I have no bulletins dated
in 1977 from Emil, my first copy
from him is dated Jan 1978. It may
be he published some in 1977
after Aug we did not get.

After reading through the bulletins
for period 1963-77 more than once
it still was difficult to determine
exactly who was Editor in some
cases. We should have added that
identification to the bulletins.

Gary and I discussed this with
what we recall, added in the
content studied and this is best I
could do. I know the finance
account was in Pierre from 1963
thru Aug 1977. The mailing
address and publication of the
bulletin was in Pierre for 1963-
Aug77 except for about a year or
so from late 1965 through 1966,
when Lien and Keyman were
putting it out. The bulletin was put
out from Pierre during Gary
Carlson's term.

Perhaps when we get these
scanned and further study is made

this list may need to be revisited.
